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Pakistan Centre of Terrorism, Pursuing its Interests in Instability of Afghanistan.

As political analysts, politicians, sociologists and political sciences have proven many times based on documents that the Pakistani military prepared the Taliban to carry out terrorist operations against foreign forces after 2003. Several Taliban were sent to Afghanistan after being brainwashed in Pakistani religious schools, headed by Sirajuddin Haqqani, the leader of the Taliban under the command of Pakistan. Before that, Pakistanis were working closely with terrorist groups like Al-Qaeda. As the killers of Ahmad Shah Masoud (the famous counter-terrorism commander in the north of Afghanistan,) entered Takhar, Afghanistan through Pakistan. Masoud was assassinated in collusion with ISI and other global intelligence networks.

Al-Qaeda had previously attacked the US Embassy in Tanzania with a suicide attack. Pakistan's military had a close relationship with al-Qaeda leaders like Osama and al-Zawahiri, even though they were wanted by America. According to experts, Pakistan managed the relationship between al-Qaeda and the Haqqani network to carry out suicide attacks in Afghanistan. Osama lived next to a Pakistani military base near the ISI headquarters for several years. Until it was reported that he was killed in Pakistan in a military operation by US helicopters in Abbottabad. But his deputy Al-Zawahiri was not attacked while he was living in Karachi and was in the crosshairs of American intelligence.

Developments in the last two decades have shown that the Taliban group is an intelligence project. For specific purposes, they were equipped and financed by Pakistan against the government and the people of Afghanistan. Now that the Taliban came to power in a political deal under the title of peace talks in Doha, the capital of Qatar. They are managed by the Pakistani military. Pakistan's ambassador in Kabul has the role of viceroy. Pakistan uses the Taliban and all

terrorist groups like Jaish-e-Mohammed, Sepal Sahaba and Lashkar-e-Jangawi as tools. Pakistan has made Afghanistan the centre of its new games in different ways by using the needs of America and considering the wide influence it has on the Taliban. Afghanistan has suffered huge financial and human losses due to Pakistan's hostile interventions.

Pakistan pursues its interests in the instability of Afghanistan. In this sense, Afghanistan has been entangled in an orchestrated war imposed on it from abroad, at the head of Pakistan and its allies. The ongoing unrest has caused several political, economic and social difficulties in Afghanistan. After the rule of the Taliban, Pakistan plans to transfer the terrorists and their leaders to Afghanistan under the rule of the Taliban, to reduce the burden of terrorism from the shoulders of its military and intelligence agencies so that this country can be removed from the sanctions list of the International Monetary Fund. To get rid of the heavy economic difficulties it is facing, Islamabad wants to make the Taliban a tool to achieve its goals.

It should be mentioned that during the Jihad with the Soviet Union, although some people raised issues under the name of martyrdom movements, any terrorist movement and suicide attacks were not allowed at that time and had no Sharia logic based on the Qur'anic verse. Perhaps the main reason was that at that time the platforms for such movements had not been prepared and many fighters were far from the reach of the Pakistani military. In general, it can be said that the jihadi commanders and the ranks of the Mujahideen and fighters, who were mostly educated people, and on the other hand, the cultural beliefs of that time, were a major obstacle to terrorist breeding.

According to international reports, al-Qaeda leader Al-Zawahiri was killed with the help of Pakistan's ISI in Sharper, Kabul. The unmanned aircraft took off from Quetta's Shamsi Airport, which is 190 kilometres away from Afghanistan, and after passing through Pakistan's airspace, it entered the airspace of Kabul without any problems and targeted the Al-Qaeda leader in a house that was under strict security. It does not matter which person and which faction of the Taliban facilitated this operation. Because the essence of the matter goes back to the Pakistani military, whose decision is decisive. The Taliban are mercenaries and listen to Pakistan's orders.

In this incident, rumour says that the Taliban showed a soft reaction and secretly moved Al-Zawahiri's body to Kandahar and buried it there. The mild reaction of

the Taliban is a sign that they are involved in this scenario or that the Pakistani military has forced them to remain silent. In this case, this question remains unanswered, if the Taliban have helped America and Pakistan in exposing Al-Zawahiri's residence; So how did their leaders leave Kabul in a hurry and took refuge in the Chauri camps in Waziristan, Quetta, their previous hideouts? This means that Pakistan is a haven for them, and America and Pakistan have secret obligations to each other in this regard.

But this story is not over yet, as the news agencies, including drones inside Ghani and according to a report in the Barman district of Paktika, killed three commanders of Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan, named Omar Khalid Khorasan, Hafiz Daulat Khan and Mullah Hassan, with the same rocket that Al-Zawahiri was one of their victims. Surprisingly, the Taliban again denied this attack the first time and said it was a mine explosion. One of the dead is Omar Khaled Khorasani, whose real name is Abdul Wali Mohmand. He was the leader of the Jamaat-ul-Ahrar group, which survived an aerial attack five years ago. It is not yet clear whether this deal was made between America and Pakistan or whether the Taliban are also involved, But the killing of another commander of Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan in Kunar by a drone and the silence of the Taliban against this attack shows a kind of understanding between the leaders of the Taliban and the government of Pakistan. In return for the death of three leaders of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan, Pakistan threw Zawahiri into the US trap. How much this action lowered the credibility and prestige of the Taliban and hurt them. This action can be interpreted as the other side of the game with terrorism, on the platform of intelligence games.

After the killing of al-Zawahiri and then the killing of three commanders of the Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan in Ghazni and then the killing of another commander of this movement in Kunar by a Pakistani drone, new events are taking place that has brought the game of terrorism between America and Pakistan. It has a new season. In the statement that he made on this occasion, Biden said that Ayman Zawahiri, the thinker of the September 11th terrorist attacks on American soil and the designer of several other terrorist attacks against American interests in other parts of the world, by removing this terrorist element as a legitimate target for America, justice was ensured in this regard. The United States with extensive military capabilities twenty-two years ago, on October 7th (2001), due to the terrorist attacks of September 11th, Afghanistan, a small country with poor and defenceless people, was subject to a military attack, and the reason for its attack was to dismantle the terrorist bases of Al-Qaeda, which had the support of the Taliban regime. The operation was accompanied by

the widespread enthusiasm of the western propaganda machine and spy agencies, created a favourable environment for justifying the military attack of the American military coalition on world public opinion, and Washington succeeded in justifying its armed attack, which lacked legal legitimacy, in the framework of legitimate defence and the fight against terrorism.

The military coalition led by the United States, which started the military occupation of Afghanistan with its tools, i.e. the continuation of the fight against terrorism and the promotion of democracy with the development of human rights standards, amid a powerful military, political and intelligence presence, turned Afghanistan into a bloody stronghold and a permanent centre of war in the mountains of this country. The terrorist group, which is not located in Afghanistan, but around the southern borders, went to the side and even violated the security and defence agreement, which calls on the American side for joint defence, that such a top-of-the-air approach, and a deliberate attack on the starting point. Terrorist centres provided the basis for the expansion of instability and the development of terrorist activities.

Thus, during the entire period of military presence in Afghanistan, Washington, as Mr Biden and his predecessor, have repeatedly revealed the main intentions of the heads of the White House regarding their unwillingness to limit the government and nation-building in Afghanistan, and continuously supported the illegitimate governments that emerged from the illegal and undemocratic elections by interfering in the Afghan elections. It caused the process of state building and establishment of governance based on the people to be weakened and the power to be divided among many mafia mercenaries. The re-collapse of Afghanistan was implemented by the US-backed regime.

American Disgraceful Deal with Terrorists:

In this disgraceful deal with the Taliban terrorists, the key people of America, Ashraf Ghani and his close associates (Hamdullah Mohib, and Fazli, who are known as the three-man government) were included, who previously created the conditions for the surrender of power. This failure of the system was formed gradually. Seven thousand Taliban terrorists, each of whom had killed hundreds of people in terrorist operations, ambushes, suicide operations, explosions and organized and chain murders, were released from prisons and all joined the ranks of the Taliban. Zalmay Khalilzad, the special representative of the US in the so-called peace talks in a secret deal in Doha strengthened the Taliban positions

politically and militarily. He is considered one of the main engineers in bringing the Taliban to power. In this failed mission, he should be tried, which has caused the killing of Afghan people and brought the Taliban terrorist group to power in collusion with Pakistan by giving false information to the US administration and the people of Afghanistan. Hamid Karzai, one of America's puppet figures, also played a key role in strengthening the Taliban positions during his presidency. These three people, Hamid Karzai and Ashraf Ghani, the puppet presidents, the US peace envoy in Doha, and Zalmay Khalilzad were the main factors in laying the groundwork for the Taliban. They must be prosecuted for the great blunders that commuted and plunged a nation to devastation.

After a tiny reflection, it can be acknowledged that all the preparations for the re-collapse of Afghanistan and the establishment of circles of terror in the heart of the regime matured under the support of the West and their developmental stages were followed in the presence of a sick and abusive system. The provision of extensive secret communication between Washington and the Taliban armed movement, which was accused of close cooperation with the feared terrorists of the American strategic policy, was the most shameful action of Kabul's strategic partners, which was formed in contradiction and conflict with the total commitments of the West with Kabul, and resulted in the signing of agreements in February 2000 in Doha.

In practice, the Doha agreement contained explicit provisions on the unconditional transfer of power to the Taliban group in its text and content from a political and legal perspective, which was signed between the United States and the armed opposition without the participation of Kabul. These agreements reflected the capitulation approach of Kabul's strategic friends under the anti-terrorist struggle that kept Afghanistan occupied for twenty years and the result was the same political, economic and social bankruptcy that is affecting our people now.

The departure of the American military even before the scheduled time after Mr Biden came to power was not an unexpected phenomenon, but it was done with the spirit of the Doha Agreement, which guaranteed the transfer of power, and the White House assured the immediate withdrawal of the military because Al-Qaeda and its supporters are another anymore threat to America's interests. Thus, the scenario of the killing of Ayman al-Zawahiri, the leader of the Al-Qaeda network in Kabul under the administration of the Taliban, was a funny demonstration of America's strategic failure in the fight against terrorism, as several senators and activists of think tanks in the United States have emphasized.

The top Republican on the House Intelligence Committee accused President Biden of deceiving Congress and the American public by diminishing the threat that al Qaeda posed to Afghanistan when withdrawing U.S. troops last year. According to the Daily Mail, Mike Turner, the Republican Representative in the Intelligence Committee of the House of Representatives of the United States of America, has admitted that the attack in the United States apparently put an end to the terror regime of Zawahiri in Kabul, but it also revealed the failure of the Biden government in dealing with the growing threats, because Biden told the American people of non-existence. Al-Qaeda in Afghanistan had assured before leaving.

Mike Turner, R-Ohio, told Fox News Digital that the killing of al Qaeda leader Ayman al-Zawahiri proved Biden was disingenuous when he argued previously that there was no reason for the U.S. to remain in Afghanistan. “The president was not being truthful,” said Turner. “Now, as they try to take a victory lap for their actions of killing Zawahiri in Afghanistan, they're having to admit that his presence in Afghanistan is evidence that al Qaeda has a foothold and a presence and a relationship with the Taliban.”

Biden argued last year that America's "forever war" in Afghanistan had run its course. The president repeatedly stressed that the initial reason for the war, to combat al Qaeda and other terrorist groups, had been achieved.

"What interest do we have in Afghanistan at this point, with al Qaeda gone," Biden said in August 2021, when defending his decision to withdraw from Afghanistan. “We went to Afghanistan for the express purpose of getting rid of al Qaeda in Afghanistan – as well as – getting Osama bin Laden. And we did.” Republicans have long argued that the White House botched the U.S. exit from Afghanistan. They say that Biden undercut the legitimacy of the prior Afghan government by withdrawing troops and abandoning billions in military aid to the Taliban. (1)

Marjory Taylor Greene a member of the House of Representatives, called the killing of al-Zawahiri a funny show and criticized Biden's role as the commander-in-chief of the shameful withdrawal from Afghanistan and accused Biden of using this issue to divert public opinion. Republican Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene of Georgia has denounced President for Joe Biden taking a "victory lap" after the death of Al-Qaeda leader Ayman al-Zawahiri. She suggested that Biden should have instead focused on issues including the botched U.S. withdrawal

from Afghanistan, a so-called "proxy war with Russia" and high inflation rates.

"Zawahiri is credited in planning 9-11 & attack on the USS Cole, but most Americans don't know or have forgotten who he is, but once they know they will be glad he's dead. But Joe's victory lap is ridiculous. Its absurd Joe is going to try to act tough on TV." "No one in America has been sweating an attack from Al Qaeda lately or even heard a thing about them, but Americans are extremely stressed about affording groceries, gas, & the Democrats the big tax hike coming soon," she added.

Also, Graham and several first-rate politicians in Congress, while speaking in the Daily Mail, have criticized the United States government for its failed strategy in Afghanistan.

In addition, the CNN television network has reported the growing concerns of the intelligence and security authorities of the United States regarding the widespread terrorist threats from Afghanistan, and it has been noted that a year ago, the White House created a security task force in the framework of the so-called over-the-horizon strategy to confront potential threats, but due to the lack of information, this team has not been able to identify a single case of terrorist movements around Afghanistan.

In response to Lindsey Graham's question about whether they are worried about an attack from Afghanistan, Grace Ray, the head of the FBI, said that yes, there is a concern, especially since we are out of Afghanistan and we are facing an information vacuum. Therefore, according to the above factors, the American authorities will not be able to kill this or that terrorist element on the soil of Afghanistan and show their black face in the face of the situation in Afghanistan with the wandering, poor and displaced people, who are facing the catastrophic violation of human rights and the growing threats of terrorism caused by the behind-the-scenes deals and strategic concealment of America. We believe that it will never be forgotten that the United States has left a sad legacy in Afghanistan with its irresponsible withdrawal, which will not be able to hide its political, moral and strategic failure in any way.

Kandahar Meeting- Renewal of Allegiance or show of Power? On Thursday, a large meeting began in Kandahar with the participation of several "ulama", officials of the Taliban government and ethnic

elders. The Taliban have claimed that around 3,000 people have been invited to this one-day meeting. This meeting was held while the killing of Ayman al-Zawahiri; The leader of al-Qaeda has overshadowed the talks between the US and the Taliban in the US drone attack in Kabul. Amir Khan Motaghi; The foreign minister of the Taliban said in this meeting that they "want positive interaction with the world". This is the second big meeting of the Taliban, after the big meeting of the Ulama last month in Kabul; A meeting that, just like the Kabul meeting, has no transparency about it, and perhaps even its participants do not know that it will not achieve anything except listening to meaningless and emotional speeches of the Taliban leaders, which are organized according to Pakistan, ISI guidance. Of course, everyone said whatever came to their mind. Taliban officials have said that the participants in the Kandahar meeting will discuss "important national issues". The Taliban, according to Pakistan's instructions, said that Mullah Haibatullah, the leader of the Taliban, had participated in the meeting. This empty claim does show that the Taliban are liars and are the spokesmen of Pakistan's intelligence and that Mullah Haibatullah was killed in Quetta, Pakistan in 2018, and Pakistan spreads its opinions and announcements in the name of Habibullah for the deviation of the world and the independence of the Taliban. While the people of Afghanistan don't know that Afghanistan is directly under the occupation of Pakistan, and the freedom movements are continuously rising all over Afghanistan against the Taliban and their supporters in Pakistan and other involved countries.

The meeting in Kandahar, like in Kabul, highlighted the mismanagement and inability of the Taliban in organizing, managing and drawing conclusions from this type of meeting by the agents of the Taliban. which caused ambiguity, complexity, lack of transparency and finally, fruitlessness. The result of these leaks is already known. According to the Taliban leaders, the participants in the meetings in Kabul and Kandahar are a forum to show their power. 1- By holding these kinds of meetings, they want to show that they have public support and that "ulama", ethnic elders and political leaders support them and their government. For this reason, Taliban leaders, during their speeches in Kabul and Kandahar meetings, continuously tried to draw the attention of the international community to it, and at the same time, they renewed their radical policies regarding the implementation of "Sharia" and the establishment of "Islamic system". And they repeated.

2- In this way, contrary to the initial expectations, both in the Kabul meeting and in the Kandahar meeting, the main principles of the Taliban's policies, most of which are based on the same approaches of the first period of "Emirate" rule, and

in fact, the same version of the Taliban are being revived was emphasized. In this meeting, they gave a clear message to the world. which does not envisage any change in their work. Under the influence of external pressures, the Taliban are not willing to change their identity and nature and their politics and governance.

3- Another point that becomes clear from such meetings is the "allegiance" of the participants to Mullah Hebat Akhundzadeh; The leader of the Taliban has no physical existence. Rather, the Pakistani general issues orders from his position like a ghost.

4- According to the Taliban, only the vote of "ulama" and tribal leaders forms the basis of the legitimacy of the "Islamic system". The general public does not have enough wisdom and knowledge to choose their political leaders. Therefore, another goal of the meetings in Kabul and Kandahar, where the participants pledge allegiance to the Taliban's "Amir al-Mu'minin" based on a tribal tradition, is to demonstrate the "internal legitimacy" of the Taliban government.

5- Therefore, in their opinion, the Taliban leaders are sending two different messages to the people of Afghanistan and the international community by holding such meetings. They tell the people that your elites and worthy representatives, religious scholars and ethnic elders, have approved the "Islamic Emirate" and pledged allegiance to the "Amir al-Mu'minin", so the system is legitimate and any opposition to it is considered "sedition".

6- They also send a message to the world that these meetings of "three thousand people" indicate the power and influence of the Taliban in Afghanistan; So the world should submit to this power and stop exerting pressure and trying to isolate the "Islamic Emirate". However, the Kandahar meeting did not have as much political, propaganda and media feedback as the Kabul meeting. One of the reasons was that the public opinion inside and outside the country had already concluded that the Kandahar meeting would not be any better, referring to the unsuccessful meeting in Kabul. Another reason was that following the killing of Ayman al-Zawahiri in Kabul, the Taliban's propaganda efforts to gain internal legitimacy or show external power are useless and cannot cover dozens of unanswered questions about the complex connections between the Taliban and al-Qaeda.

In Conclusion: Recent events show that terrorist groups are the death of

countries that support terrorism and indicate a change in the way terrorism is played. Therefore, terror, terrorists, terrorism, and supporters of terrorism all have a common origin, and with the term, they all die from the cold. Everyone pursues the same goal, which is to achieve strategic goals in every country, region and world. Their victim is an oppressed person. The enmity of many countries with terrorism is not a reality; Rather, its purpose is to deceive people, and the deviation of the world's opinion concerning the fight against terrorism. The games under the name of fighting terrorism are giving new life to terrorist groups like al-Qaeda so that its young leaders enter the battlefield and provide better opportunities to achieve the goals of the countries that are actors of terrorism, including the supporters and seemingly enemies of terrorism.

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
